Explore the Archives: A Step-by-Step Guide

- 1. **Start on the homepage:** Go to bangordailynews.com/archives. Note if you start directly on newspapers.com, your subscription will not be recognized.
- 2. If you are elsewhere on the site, **navigate to Archives:** Find and click 'Archives' at the top of the BDN site. **Make sure you're logged in to your account.**





4. Find the yellow button: In the top right corner, click the yellow 'Bangor Daily News' button.



- Sign-in prompt: A pop-up will now appear. Click 'Sign up for free' at the bottom of the pop-up window.
- 6. Register with email: Click 'Register with Email' on the registration pop-up window.
